He also went back to school to further his knowledge, convinced that success comes from knowing every detail of one's products and services.

Mr Fernandez's deep sense of professionalism quickly distinguished PestBusters from its peers. Never one to take shortcuts, PestBusters takes an integrated and rigorous approach by inspecting the site of the infestation before recommending the right solution to minimise the potential harm to the surrounding environment.

Having reaped the benefits of rigorous training, Mr Fernandez is committed to equip his associates with the best possible training opportunities. In his vision, every associate should be an Ambassador of the company – ready to live up to the highest standards. Since the company's founding in 1991, this exacting vision has won the trust of its clients, including the most renowned names in the Healthcare and Hospitality markets.

Under Mr Fernandez's leadership, PestBusters has grown its presence in competitive markets across Southeast Asia, with offices in Singapore, Malaysia, Vietnam and the Philippines. He has also set his sights on the wider Asian region – by 2020, PestBusters is set to expand its presence to Cambodia, India, Sri Lanka, China and Indonesia. The company has also set up a
